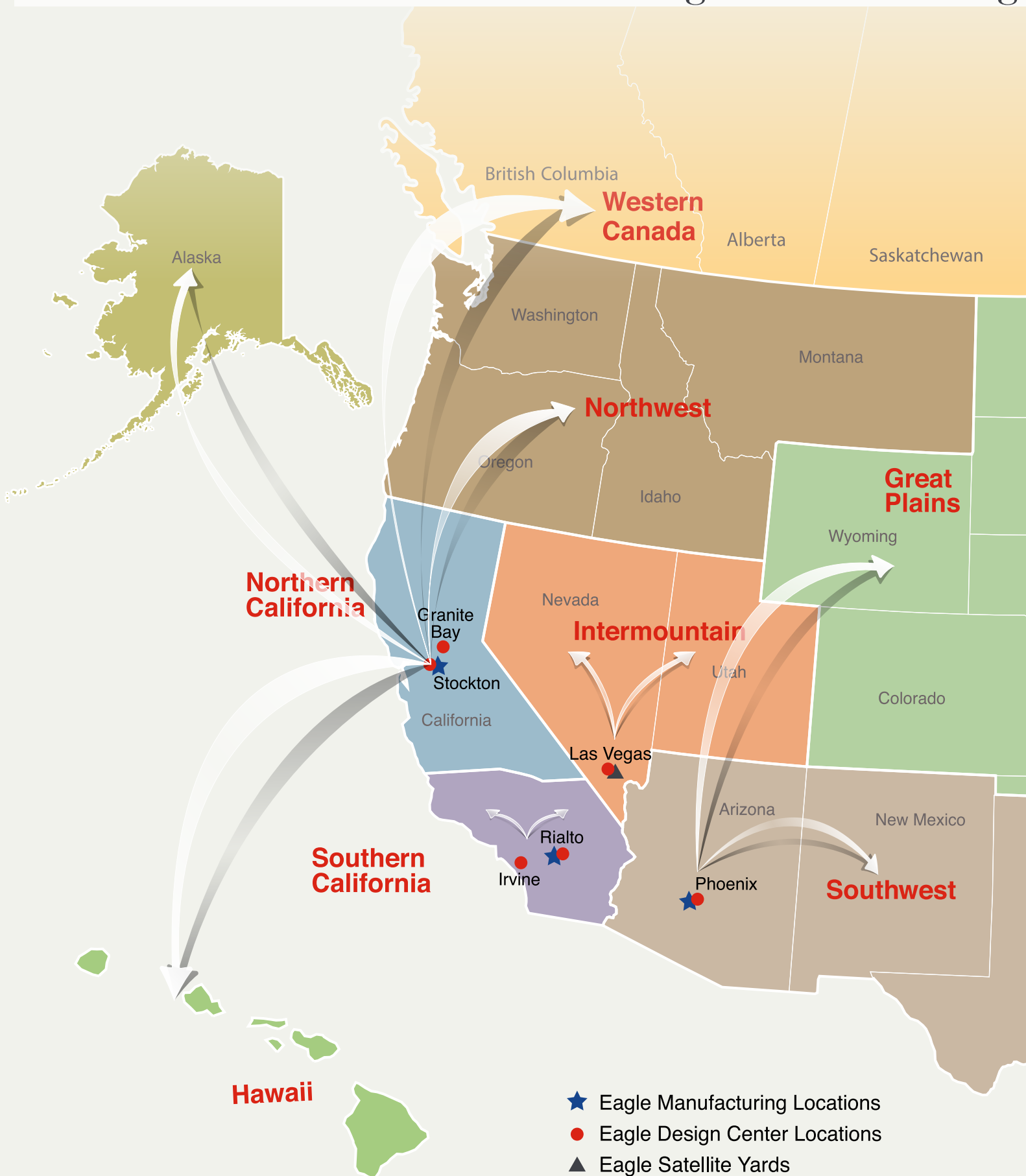
Blended Tile
